Sue Chandler

Sue is a highly sought after EA NCAS Level 2 General Coach, EA NCAS Level 3 Dressage Coach, EA Coach and Judge Educator and an EA NOAS "A" Level Dressage Judge/ Mentor and has successfully competed in many FEI competitions over the years. She enjoys teaching beginners as well as advanced riders and horses, and her simple and friendly coaching style is appreciated by all who attend her lessons.

Rebecca Ashton

Rebecca is a BHS trained. EA accredited (Level 1 dressage specialist) coach and a fully qualified pilates instructor and Oov practitioner. As well as having trained and competed horses up to FEI level, she has helped everyone from beginners to Olympians with their body awareness and fitness to help them improve their performance in the saddle.

With her dressage, Rebecca has trained in Europe on several occasions and is still a regular visitor. She also continues to train movement practice with the best in the industry, including Adelinde Cornelissen and her fitness coach in Holland.

Anne grew up on a farm in the South East, so she has fond memories of riding and competing in the area. Anne's love of Dressage really began when she was 14 and I purchased her first "big" horse, a 6yo TB eventer who required lots of flat training and she hasn't looked back since!

Anne takes pride in and enjoys training her horses from when they are started through the levels herself. Anne's training methods are best described as Modern / Classical as she follows the German Training Scale but has a keen interest in the bio mechanics and psychology of the horse as well as arena craft.

Lyrical, Anne's Grand Prix horse has recently retired to give pony rides to her daughter. She has two current horses Favco who is about to start Prix St George and Shadows Tollinski who is at Novice level as well as riding and training clients horses.

An EA Level 1 General and Dressage Coach as well as Level 2 Dressage Specialist Coach, Anne enjoys coaching riders of all levels.

Jim Moore

Jim always creates a calm respectful atmosphere to which both horses and riders can achieve and walk away with a happy feeling. He has a unique ability to educate and control horses, working with so many varying levels of riders and horses, ensuring the riders are in control before any training commences and being aware of problems that may arise. Jim uses very simple basic language to guide with an encouraging manner to show his way to achieve long lasting results. Success in retraining, float loading, eliminating bad habits and rude behaviour, Jim is legendary. Many people have been privy to Jim's in-ate training of his own horses and hold much respect for him and his knowledge gained through a life time of experience.

Jim started attending Pony Club regularly from age 7 – 15 competing in eventing, show jumping and novelties. At age 14 took on breaking and training horses for others for many disciplines. By 18 he was living and working in Warrnambool with Alan Fleming, breaking and training station horses from Guns of Goondiwindi destined for the Polo fields. From teen years to mid-20's regularly hunted, with Penola Hunt Club, holding office as Deputy Master. Jim has competed successfully in Point to Points, Hunt Club Cups, Tent Pegging, Show Jumping, Played Polo Cross to State Championships Level.

Jim has trained and re-educated many horses to success in the hack, dressage and stock horse arenas. Several Stock horses have been successful at championship level in led, ridden, working and challenge events. Jim regularly starts young thoroughbreds to go on to become successful performances horses in various competition arenas. He holds an owner trainer license in racing with success of some 30 winners. Jim has also educated horses for harness.

Jim is accredited with the Australian Stock Horse Society as trainer and coach at stock horse organised clinics as has been training people to understand and ride for many years one on one and in small groups.

Michele Meijer

Michele has been involved in horses all her life. Fell in love with dressage in early 20's when she met her coaches. With their coaching Michele trained her appaloosa gelding from the beginning right through to competing in Grand Prix in SA. She is an advanced level instructor with HSA and working Equitation Australasia.

Michele has always believed in classical principles and that dressage training was the basis from which all else springs from for all horses. She left competition to follow her heart and breed Morgans. All her Morgans are dressage trained to FEI movements but they do anything from school horses to cattle work and archery.

Working Equitation is based on these principles and is the perfect sport to utilise dressage training and have some fun as well.

Horse Bit Emporium

Loren Wellings is an accredited Bit Fitter – more information is available on her website

Bitting for almost 5 years now, I pride myself on the knowledge of assisting many horses. Every horse is different and sure has a story to tell in their bitting! Bitting has evolved and there is so much to learn about how the bit can affect our horse's way of going, behaviour, steadiness and moving. We should be taking it more seriously, similar to Saddle Fitting!

Most common thing I see with bitting is incorrectly fitted bits. Or the rider is using a bit that came with the horse or that they found in the tack shed! I would estimate that approximately 1 out of every 10 horses that I see to, has mouth damage. Not just splitting of the lips, but internal damage to either the bars of the mouth, teeth or inner lip.

For Loren to be able to attend we will need a minimum of 16 horses.

HRCav Level Assessments

HRCav (Horse Riding Clubs Association of Victoria) is a national organisation with nearly 6000 members and 240 clubs throughout Victoria and NSW. It allows riders from 5-75 to ride and compete in various disciplines against riders of a similar assessed level of competency. HRCav is all about creating a level playing field and having fun across multiple disciplines. Members of the HRCav facet of MSEDc can get level assessed for only \$20 per horse and rider combination. You and your horse will be assessed as a combination in your chosen discipline/s. You can choose all/one/a couple of the following disciplines: dressage, showing, show jumping, combined training (this is a mix of dressage & show jumping). Bookings essential for time allocation. You need separate assessments for each horse you ride.
