These Awards will be presented at the Lucindale Show in February



Wood Duck -

A member who has done something funny or silly throughout the year, for example going to a dressage competition and forgetting your saddle!

Autumn Leaves -

A member who gracefully dismounts, without intention, their trusty steed, either at home or at a competition. It must be a fall that the member does not get seriously injured. If there are no graceful dismounts nominated then it can be an unmounted dismount that can be nominated (falling from the mounting block...)

Presidents Award -

Awarded to a member who the president chooses as a valuable contributor to the club during the year.

Volunteer of the year -

Awarded to a club member/s who go above and beyond helping the club in any way or form consistently throughout the year, to be discussed and decided by the committee

Horse/Member Combination of the year -

A horse and rider combination who gains points throughout the year at club run events.
Club days = 1 point for each day attended,
AGM = 1 point,
Competitions = 1 point for each test ridden, plus points given for placing depending on number of entries.

If one in the class, 2 points awarded.

If two in the class, 3 points for 1st, 2 points for 2nd.

If three in the class, 4 points for 1st, 3 points for 2nd, 2 points for 3rd.

If 4 or more in the class, 5 points for 1st, 4 points for 2nd, 3 points for 3rd, 2 points for 4th, 1 point for each competitor after that.

A point is awarded for each test ridden even if you were eliminated.

Racing SA OTT Award -

A thoroughbred and rider combination who gains points throughout the year at club run events who has trialed or raced. Points are allocated the same way as horse of the year.

- The organizing committee, Lucindale PA&H Society, MSEDCA, EA and HRCVA does not accept any liability or responsibility for any accident, injury, illness, loss or damage to any person, property or animal.
- **Stock Horses must be members of ASHS**
- All competitors must present to the gear check before competing
Dogs must be on a leash at all times
- The committee reserves the right to cancel or alter any class at their discretion.
- Hot weather times may be used in extreme weather conditions. Notification will be via the MSEDCA website and facebook page
- Current, valid HRCVA membership and dressage performance card must be presented to the Event Secretary prior to competing in HRCVA classes
- Riders may only compete in a maximum of 3 EA tests per day
- If a rider is eligible to compete in BOTH HRCVA and EA tests, then they may only compete in a total of 4 tests in any one day, irrelevant of the test affiliation eg: 2 EA tests and 2 HRCVA tests = 4 tests total. This is the maximum.
- HRCVA registered club colours must be worn in HRCVA tests
- HRCVA riders must supply their own numbers for both sides of the horse
- HRCVA rules and regulations apply to HRCVA tests and HRCVA riders
- HRCVA riders may compete at their assessed Level and the next higher Level
- HRCVA prizes as per Event Rule 25
- EA rules and regulations apply to all other tests and riders
- Anyone who pays a Lucindale PA&H Society membership is eligible to enter the Closed Restricted classes
- **Stock Horse Tests are judged under EA Rules with the exception of saddle, nose bands and dress. Current EA hard hat rules apply.**

Risk Warning for over 18yrs

1. I, the undersigned acknowledge, agree and understand that participation, including passive

participation, in horse sport activities at this, or at any show contains an element of risk of injury and I agree that I undertake any such risk voluntarily of my own free will and at my own risk.

2. I, the undersigned acknowledge, agree, and understand the dangers associated with the consumption

of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before, and during the activities and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during any horse sport activities.

3. I, the undersigned acknowledge the risk referred to above and agree to waive any and all rights that I,

or any other person claiming through me, may have against the LUCINDALE PASTORAL, AGRICULTURAL & HORTICULTURAL SOCIETY INC in relation to any loss or injury (including death) that is suffered by me as a result of my participation at this show.

Time to check your horses for sand Do the simply bucket test now be on top of managing your horse

Causes of Sand Colic in Horses The cause of your horse developing sand colic will be discussed in detail below. His age - Young horses tend to not care as much as their older counterparts about what they are eating/ingesting His grazing location - If he is eating in an area where there is a lot of sand, he is at risk of ingesting large amounts His being fed off the ground - If your horse eats spilled feed off the ground, for example, he is at an increased risk of ingesting sand His housing - A sand floor in the stall Intestinal blockage - Once the sand begins to accumulate in your horse's stomach his intestines may begin to twist and change direction
