2023 ThoroughCare SA OTT State Dressage Series

With the help of ThoroughCare SA, Dressage SA would like to recognise and celebrate the riders that have taken on Off The Track thoroughbred horses and retrained them into dressage horses. 2023 will see the introduction of the ThoroughCare SA OTT State Dressage Series. Qualifying events will be run at different dressage clubs around the state throughout 2023. Prize money will be on offer at each of these club qualifiers with a series final to be held in January 2024.

Levels of Competition:

- Preparatory
- Preliminary
- Novice

Qualifying events

- . Two tests will be offered at each club at each level
- Rosettes will be presented to the 1st -6th place getters in each test at each level
- Prize money will be presented to the overall 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners of the combined tests at each level, using rule 3.19

For the purpose of deciding an overall winner at a level, the following criteria will decide the winner:

- a) first placed horses will be allocated 35 points
- b) second placed will be allocated 34 points
- c) third placed will be allocated 33 points and so on to the last placed horse
- d) competitors must compete in both tests at level the nominated to be eligible for points
- e) the winner is the horse with the highest combined points of the two tests
- f) in the event of a tie, the winner will be the horse with the highest aggregate percentage at that level
- g) in the event of a further tie, the horse with the highest percentage in the higher competition at that level will be deemed the winner

Series Final

- · To ride at the Series Final the horse must have competed at one qualifying events
- Rosettes will be presented to the 1st -6th placegetters in each test
- Prize money will be presented first 3 placegetters at each level
- Custom made rugs will be presented to the series winners featuring the Thorough Care SA logo at each level
- · Winners will be decided on results from the series final only

- · A member of the host club
- · AN ESA competitive or Participant member

Thank you for booking in for the Extravaganza this year. Please find attached the time table for the weekend. If you have any questions please contact Linda Archer 0427 208 180. There is a couple of spare lessons available, if you would like an extra one please contact me. Unfortunately we didn't get enough bookings for Sue Chandler and the Bit Fi so these have been cancelled. If you paid for a bit fitting we will refund you the money, please let me know your bank details.

The grounds will be open Friday afternoon. There is plenty of camping space and yards if you haven't booked and decide you would like to stay please let us know. The cost is \$30 for the weekend.

Set up will be Friday afternoon if anyone is available to help that would be wonderful.

We are very fortunate to be able to use the lovely watered, shady grounds; please remember to drive around the Polocrosse fields. I have attached a venue map to assist you.

The grounds are at Hynam which is approx. 10kms east of Naracoorte on the Edenhope Road. You take the road sign posted to Francis and then the first road on your right; the Polocrosse grounds are at the end of that road. Be careful of the 2 drains across the road at the cross roads.

At this stage the weather forecast is looking okay to ride. If this does change the following may apply.

- . We may alter the timetable to avoid the hottest time of the day.
- If the forecast is for a Catastrophic Fire Day in the Lower South East (SA) the Extravaganza will be cancelled

Other notes:

- Please ensure you are warmed up ready to ride at your scheduled time.
- Manure can be left in yards or spread anywhere but on the polocrosse fields
- Rubbish to be put in bins and recycling in marked bins
- Please let me know if you have any dietary restrictions so that we can endeavour to cater for you.
- Please remember your helmets etc

- Please bring a cake or slice to share for morning and afternoon tea
- BYO for Lunches
- Saturday night dinner will be a BBQ the club will provide the meat but everyone who
