# Nothing is impossible The word itself says "I'm Possible"!

## What will happen if

Have you ever learnt the wrong test!!!! Have you ever entered at A, halted at X, saluted, all going brilliantly only to turn right at C and the judge stops you and your informed you 've turned the wrong way. No you say until you realize you have learnt the wrong test. OMGosh!!!

The Judges usual process would be to ring the bell and confirm with the rider that they have learnt the wrong test and immediately give them the opportunity to read the correct test and see if they can recall it. If they can't recall it inform the rider that they will be allowed to have a caller if one is immediately in the vicinity. (To facilitate the draw timetable). This is only applicable where a caller is allowed under EA rules. Either way an error is applied, and judging commences from the point where the error was made. If none of this has been possible or the rider decides not to continue, they are counted as Retiring. That is their choice.

Where an event such as State and National championships does not permit callers,

as per Rule 10.3, learning the wrong test would probably lead to elimination."

Under no circumstances is the rider permitted to leave the arena and come back at a later time. This would constitute elimination.

Of course, at a Participant or Restricted Club event, the judge may choose to follow a different process in order to be "rider friendly". Judges are on the competitors side but must keep the event flowing for other competitors,. Bottom line, can be good to check when you present to the Judge which test you are riding.

From January 2024 all official EA Dressage Competitions will be required to have an official steward present for the during of the competition. MSEDC, in conjunction with EASA, are proud to host a Dressage Steward Seminar to enable the training of stewards in the regional areas. This seminar is fully funded by EASA.

To become an EA Official, you need to be physically fit and mentally alert with the ability to concentrate for long periods of time, often with minimal breaks! As an EA Official, you are part of a team. You must be approachable and be able to liaise well with the Organising Committee, other Officials and Riders.

#### Steward - Level 1:

Pre-requisites to becoming an EA National Steward:

You must:

- Be at least 18 years of age (16 and under 18 year olds can attend a Mentoring programme under the supervision and guidance of an accredited steward – this will count towards the shadowing experiences but accreditation will not be given until the age of 18 is reached)
- · Current EA Membership
- Attendance to EA Discipline Specific Level 1 Steward Course
- Completion Risk Management Task
- Generic and Discipline specific ORBT, with a pass mark of 80%
- Personal fitness level that will enable them to physically complete the practical requirements of the course, and the duties required of an EA Steward
- Completion of Sport Australia online Community Officiating General Principles <a href="https://www.sportaus.gov.au/coaches">https://www.sportaus.gov.au/coaches</a> and officials/officials
- 2 x Shadow Steward appointments (with FEI Steward preferably with different mentors)
